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We do recommend pre-conception testing. That can be things like blood work, having a full physical examination, testing for STD's, testing for anemia and cholesterol, testing for communicable diseases that could affect the pregnancy.

So, whenever someone has a pregnancy, we always check for sexually transmitted illnesses as well as other infectious diseases.

Commonly we test for HIV, Syphilis, Hepatitis, titers for Rubella and Chicken Pox.

And we'll also screen you for gonorrhea and chlamydia during the pregnancy.

To make sure that when your baby is born, we have the pediatricians aware of any information that they need to know.
