Women always are curious about their baby's sex and the due date. Usually at that first prenatal visit, we ask when your last menstrual period was and that usually is how we determine the due date.

So once we're able to determine the first day of your last menstrual period, we use that in conjunction with the first trimester ultrasound.

We'll do an ultrasound in the office to look and make sure the dating is correct.

Ultrasound done in the first trimester is one of the best early detecting markers for how far along a woman is in pregnancy. So those two tests done in combination, give us the most accurate form of how far along the woman is.
