As you get closer to delivery you will see your doctor with increased frequency.

We are excited to see you more often at that point. We want to make sure that your blood pressure is staying normal. We want to talk to you a lot about fetal movement and symptoms of labor.

We'll ask you about uterine contractions.

Or heavy bleeding coming from the vagina. That heavy bleeding may accompany the uterine contractions.

If your baby isn't moving then we want to hear about that as well.

You'll be asked whether you've experienced severe headaches, spots in front of your eyes or right upper quadrant pain; those are important things for you to keep an eye out and be able to let your provider know.
